Who we serve:

Waypoint's Host Home Program (HHP) is a volunteer-based housing program for at-risk transitional age youth aged 18 to 24.

Referrals for this program come from the Prioritization List in the Coordinated Entry (CE) of the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) of NH.

Young people from this list are further assessed by Waypoint. If determined as a qualified fit for this program, the Host Home Coordinator will then recruit and match a young person to a host. This host may be a natural support already in the young persons' life, or it may be a new community member volunteer. All hosts are screened and assessed and will receive a monthly stipend to help offset the cost of another person staying in their home.

The duration of this program is up to 12 months. Host Home Coordinator supports both Young Adults and Hosts for the entire duration of their participation in the program.

Our support is confidential, non-judgmental, inclusive, and free. We will help you find the right host/guest situation for you!

Waypoint Host Home Program serves young people and host-homes in Merrimack and Strafford Counties. The following towns are:
